On October 2nd, Governor Ralph Northam released the 2018 Virginia Energy Plan, which provides a strategic vision for the Commonwealth's energy policy over the next 10 years. Virginia Joins Regional Transportation Climate Initiative



The Commonwealth of Virginia on September 12th became the 13th U.S. jurisdiction to join the Transportation and Climate Initiative (TCI). In a letter to the Georgetown Climate Center, which facilitates TCI on behalf of the participating state agencies, Virginia Natural Resources Secretary Matthew Strickler announced that Virginia will work with TCI toward regional low-carbon transportation solutions. **[more]**

Medium-Duty Propane Engine Closing in on "Near-Zero" Emissions

Last year, alternative-fuel vehicle technology company ROUSH CleanTech introduced a propane autogas engine that was 75-percent cleaner than the EPA's emissions standard for nitrogen oxide. This low-NOx 0.05 g/bhp-hr propane engine comes standard on all of the company's 6.8L V10 3V propane vehicles.



The 2018 School Bus Rebate Program will offer over \$9 million to public and private fleet owners for the replacement of old diesel school buses with new buses certified to EPA's cleanest emission standards. EPA will award selected applicants \$15,000-20,000 per bus for scrapping and replacing old buses. . **{more}**

U.S. Department of Transportation Announces \$84.5 Million in Grants to Support Advanced Bus Technology Projects Nationwide



The U.S. Department of Transportation's (DOT) Federal Transit Administration (FTA) today announced \$84.45 million in grant selections through the Low- or No-Emission (Low-No) Grant program, which funds the deployment of transit buses and infrastructure that use advanced propulsion technologies. Fifty-two projects in 41 states will receive a share of the funding.
