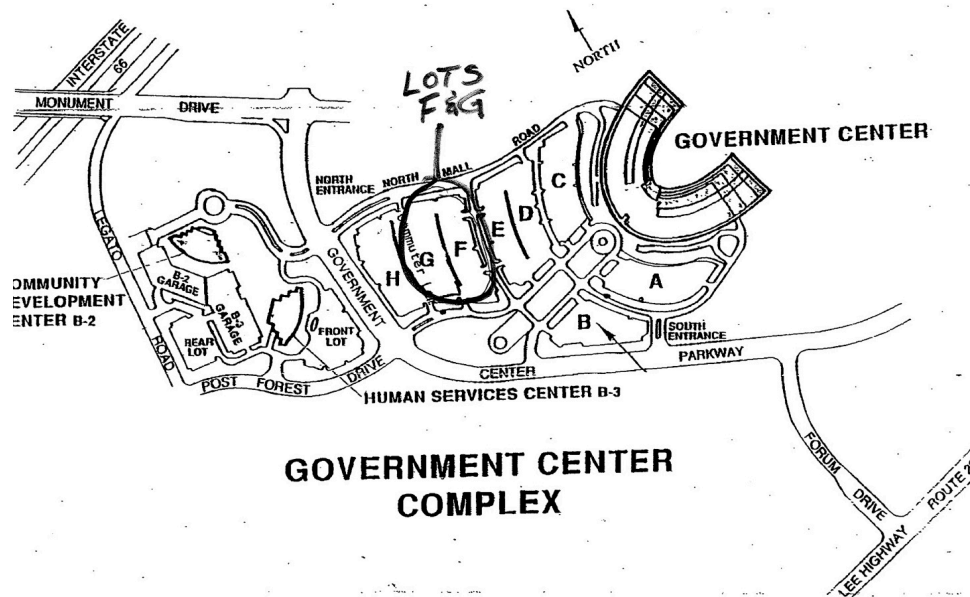


March 23rd EcoDriving Workshop – Parking and EcoDriving Instructions

We are especially excited about the driving portion of the workshop as attendees will have the opportunity to practice driving tips learned through a workshop presentation on fuel economy. To facilitate the driving portion of the event please consider the following:

- 1) Carpool to the workshop with a colleague.** (Make sure both are pre-registered!) If you arrive alone you may be paired with someone for the ecodriving and Ride & Drive segment. One person will be the driver and one will be the ScanGauge™ assistant and navigator.
- 2) Drivers will connect a ScanGauge™ tool to the vehicle prior to departure.** The unit will operate in any light duty vehicle 1996 or newer. You will be instructed on how to set up the equipment to read information from the vehicle's Engine Control Module as part of the workshop. You will need to know: the make, model, year, engine displacement size of the vehicle that will be driven. If you don't know this upon arrival you will be instructed on where to find this information.
- 3) Vehicle operators will drive a prescribed route** that has been mapped out for the occasion. You will do this twice. First to create a baseline reading, and again to observe how simple changes affect fuel economy. The Scan Gauge assistant in your vehicle will help navigate, keep notes on your fuel economy and may also coach you on how to improve mileage on your second drive.
